
Organizing an Informational Text:

Often the text teaches about one main topic, but divides the information up so there are parts about several smaller points (or sub topics).

We can organize the sub-topics (or chapters) to show different:



Kinds

Darts

· examples

· ways

We can organize the sub-topics with different structures to match the information:



· A pro and a con section

· A partly the same and partly different section

• A part that is told in sequential order - 1st, 2nd, 3rd 4th etc

We can organize the sub-topics with narratives that teach information:



- · The whole chapter could be written as a story
- There would be a small moment used as evidence to support a point
 - · There could be a story that begins (or ends) a chapter
